CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Any approval granted will be subject to the following general conditions:

1. An application must be approved - prior to placing the container on public land.
2. The size, shape and colour of all building waste containers placed on a public street shall be to the satisfaction of Council.
3. The building waste container provided shall bear the name, address and telephone number of the supplier. In all cases, an after hours telephone number shall also be displayed.
4. The supplier of the building waste container shall indemnify Council against any claim or suit arising as a result of the activity specified in the Application Form. Details of the Suppliers Public Liability Policy (endorsed to note Council's interest) shall be supplied to Council - prior to placement of any container.
5. Each building waste container shall be provided with warning lights or reflectors as required by Council.
6. Each building waste container supplied shall be in good condition and properly cleaned prior to delivery.
7. Council reserves the right to order the removal of any building waste container despite any prior approval, if such container, or the activity associated with it in the opinion of Council, causes a nuisance.
8. Putrescible waste, dangerous or hazardous waste shall not be placed in any building waste container located on public land.
9. The Supplier shall undertake to remove any waste deposited in or around the building waste container, whether by him/herself, or at their direction, or by any other person.
10. A deposit of \$318 must be lodged with Council by the Supplier prior to placement of the container as security against damage to the site and /or subsequent site clean up. Alternatively, Council will consider accepting an acceptable bond of \$2,000 from individual Suppliers covering all approved installations of building waste containers supplied in the Shire. A \$63.70 application fee is payable for each instance of a building waste container placed on public land within the Shire.
